Summer Camp Equine Director

Job Description

Manage and implement educational programs for summer camps at natural horsemanship center in Fall City, Wash. This is a contract teaching position for three months during the summer (June, July, August). It reports to the Director of Education/Owner.

Key Responsibilities

Assist in developing and implementing camp lesson program for children 8 – 16 years old, supervise and direct camp counselor staff, and act as lead instructor during camp equine sessions.

Job Duties

Manage and assign day-to-day responsibilities of camp counselors, CITs and interns
Assist in developing and implementing camp lesson plans
Mentor young counselors in advancing their skills as a horse person and valued employee
Supervise management and care of camp horses
Other duties as assigned or agreed upon

Skill Requirements

Background and education in natural horsemanship
Minimum 1 – 2 years of equestrian teaching experience
Degree, certification or equivalent experience in equine studies and/or teaching
Knowledge and proficiency with business software and computers

Desirable Experience

Position as camp counselor or director
Participation in or leader of 4H equine club or equivalent learning program
Participation in Western or English competitions

Compensation

Earnings are based on number of camps worked. Contract position is for 3 months. Contractor will receive an IRS Form 1099. Earnings Potential: \$4,500 - \$6,250, based on experience. Additional income opportunities are available for teaching and horse training outside of camp hours.
