Job Description

Manage and implement educational programs and training for natural horsemanship center in Fall City, Wash. This is a contract teaching and training position with revenue-generating responsibilities. It reports to the Director of Education/Owner.

Key Responsibilities

Assist in implementing lesson program, kids' camps, kids' club and intensive study classes. Oversee and assure individual advancement of students under your tutelage. Manage day-to-day horse training and assist in developing and/or teaching equine education courses.

Job Duties

Teach lessons in Western and English riding disciplines to customers aged 8 and above
Direct and implement kids programs including summer camps and kids club
Manage day-to-day duties of camp counselors, CITs and interns
Assist in developing program outlines and curricula for workshops and intensive study classes
Start young horses and provide foundational training
Other duties as assigned or agreed upon

Skill Requirements

Background and education in natural horsemanship
Degree, certification or equivalent experience in equine studies and/or teaching
Minimum 1 – 2 years of equestrian teaching experience
Experience starting colts and training horses using natural horsemanship techniques
Knowledge and proficiency with business computers, applications and social media

Desirable Experience

Position as camp counselor or director
Participation in or leader of 4H equine club or equivalent learning program
Participation in Western or English competitions
Facilitated or participated in equine-facilitated learning and/or therapy

Compensation

Earnings are based on number of lessons taught and training sessions conducted. Customer retention and revenue generation are key factors in determining compensation. Additional compensation is available as camp equine director and/or course instructor. Contract length is up to 12 months. Contractor will receive an IRS Form 1099.
