Camp Counselor

Job Description

Teach and supervise children age 5 – 16 participating in summer horse camps and help monitor horse health and prepare school horses for camp activities. The camp is located in Fall City, Wash. This is a part-time contract position. Chosen candidate reports to the Camp Equine Director and Director of Education.

Key Responsibilities

Assist in implementing camp lesson program and activities
Oversee and assure individual advancement of students under your tutelage
Supervise and assure the safety of campers

Job Duties

Teach lessons in natural horsemanship to campers
Handle horses and monitor their performance and health
Attend daily staff meetings
Share in supervising and participating in non-equine camp activities
Other duties as assigned or agreed upon

1-3 years' experience working with horses
Desire and patience to teach children
Strong work ethic
14 years of age or older

Desirable Experience

Experience with natural horsemanship techniques
Successful completion of the NWNHC Camp Counselor Certificate class ([See details](#))
Participation in 4H equine club or equivalent learning program
Experience with child care

Compensation

Earnings are based on number of camp sessions worked. Additional compensation is available by providing before- and after-camp child care. (Direct arrangement is made with parent.) Contractor will receive an IRS Form 1099-MISC. A portion or all services provided may be eligible for credit towards community service hours or NWNHC, LLC products and services.

Counselor (14 and older):

Counselors under the age of 16 must complete a Parent Authorization for Summer Work form if they wish to be paid. Compensation can also be in the form of credits towards community service hours or NWNHC, LLC products and services.

Earnings Potential: \$250 - \$3,320

Counselor In Training (Under 14 years of age):

Compensation for CITs is in the form of credits towards community service hours or NWNHC, LLC lessons and horse rentals.
